

Paper Plate Spiderweb



You will need:

- Paper Plate
- Paint
- Paintbrush
- Scissors
- String
- Hole punch

Extras (if you want to):

- Googly eyes

Directions:

Step 1.

Have your child paint a paper plate in whatever colour they like and wait for it to dry (or you could use a coloured paper plate).

Step 2.

Paint your child's hand and four fingers using black paint. Press their hand into the centre of the plate to make a handprint. Then press down again on top of the handprint, but facing the other direction to make a spider! If you like, stick some googly eyes onto your spider when it dries!

Step 3.

Use a hole punch to make holes around the outside of the plate (if you don't have a hole punch you can use the end of a pen or pencil and carefully poke some holes through).

Step 4.

Cut a decent length of string and get your child to thread the string through the holes to make a web!

Now you have your very own Spider Web – just like the story!
